PLACEMENT OVERVIEW

The placement process at FMS Delhi was divided into two parts, the Lateral and the Final placement processes. Students with greater than 18 months of work experience prior to their MBA participated in the Lateral placement process in December 2025. Subsequently, the Final placement process for the remaining students was held in January 2026.

To ensure a smooth and transparent process for companies, several important measures were undertaken. Firstly, a slotting exercise was conducted to democratically determine when each company would participate in the placement process. Additionally, for the ninth consecutive year, a scheduling algorithm was implemented to optimally match the preferences of both companies and students during the recruitment exercise.

FMS continues to uphold a strong culture of experiential learning, enabling students to complement their academic foundation with practical insights from the corporate world. Building on this, FMS further strengthened its Arthashastra leadership talk series, inviting business leaders across industries to engage with students and share real-time perspectives. Over the past year, the institute hosted 150+ such sessions, significantly deepening corporate interaction.

This surge in engagement not only enhanced students' learning experience but also translated into outstanding performances in some of the country's most prestigious corporate competitions. Additionally, it reinforced the institute's corporate engagement ecosystem, culminating in a record participation of 119 companies in the recruitment process, with 99 companies extending offers to students.

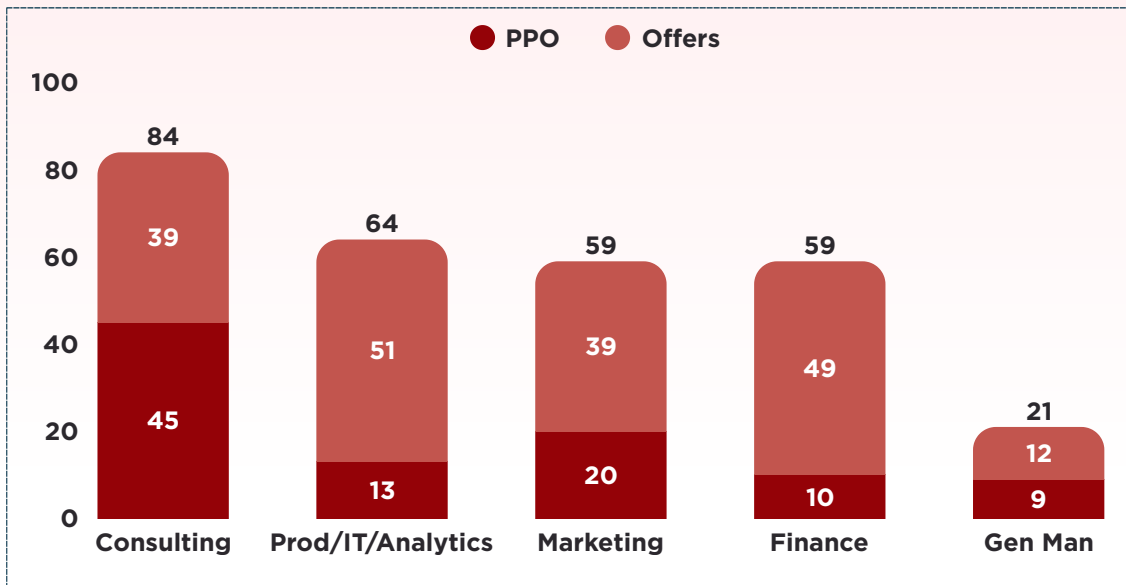

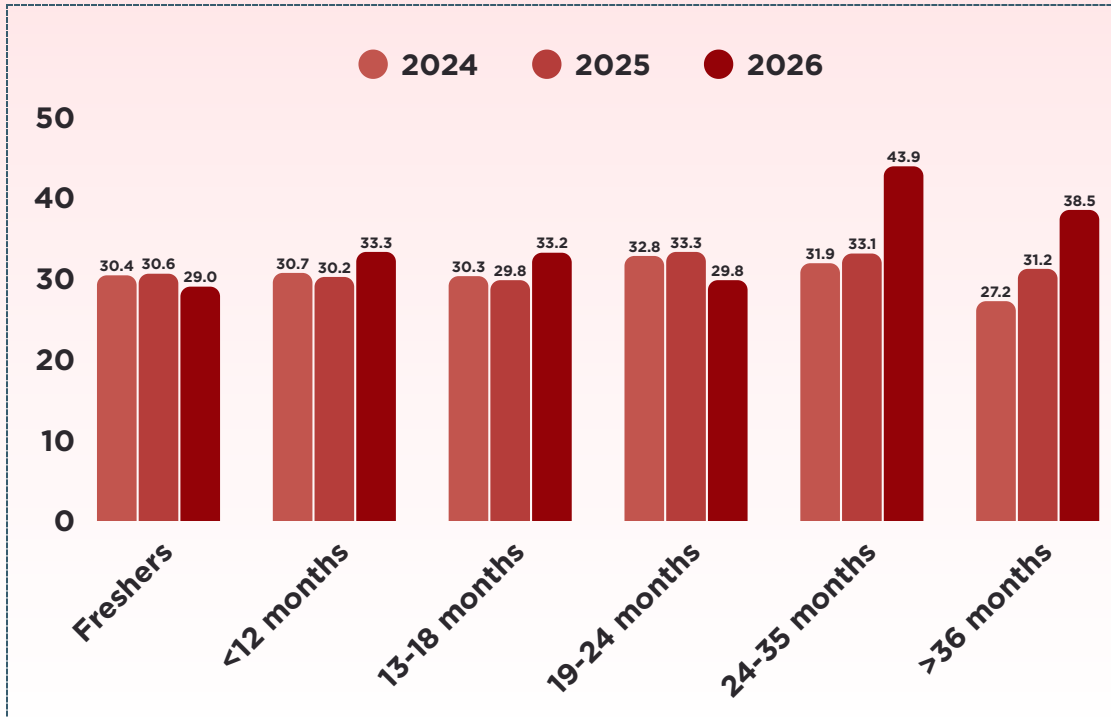

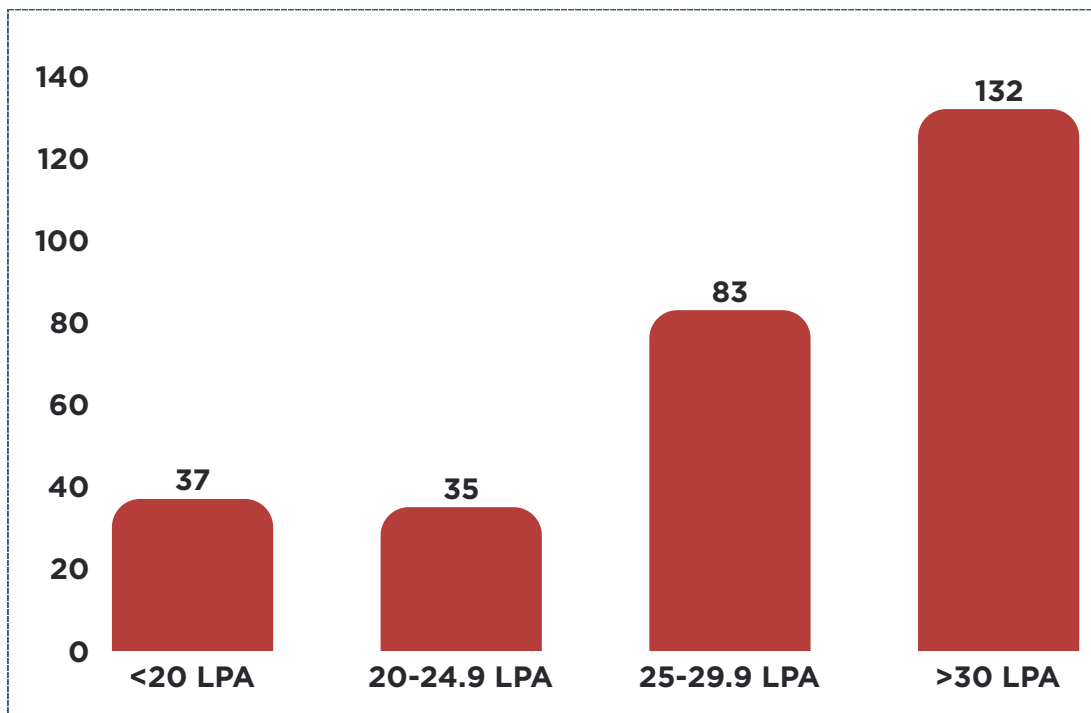
